Steubenville Office Relocation Questions

Q: After the relocation which and how many providers will be at the Weirton office?

A: On any given week day, the Weirton office will be staffed with four to six providers M-F.

Q: Can I select a particular provider?

A: For WellCare exams, you may continue to select your provider of choice. For AcuteCare needs, you may always request a particular provider if availability that day allows but remember the emphasis for AcuteCare is getting your child seen as soon as conditions warrant and often times that means the next possible appointment.

Q: Is there a new physician planning to use Suite 205 space?

A: First Steps is planning to rent the space to Trinity Hospital for one of its specialists.

Q: How far is the Weirton office from Steubenville?

A: 9.5 miles

Q: Does the Weirton office have lab and diagnostics close by?

A: YES! Lab and X-Ray are both a few steps away from the check-in areas at the Weirton office.

Q: Will FSP providers still see patients in the hospital at Trinity?

A: Absolutely. Dr. Suray, Dr. Kleifgen, Dr. Seningen and PA Curtis will all continue admitting privileges at Trinity Hospital.

Q: Why are you moving?

A: The size of the Steubenville office greatly limits how many patients can be seen on any given day. With two independent floors at Weirton (one dedicated to acute patients and one dedicated to well patients) more resources can be made available to a greater number of patients.

Q: What if we do not want to travel ?

A: Shawna Minella, our Relocation Coordinator, can help you find a provider that works for you. Shawna may be reached at 740-266-2200.

Q: Do you have plans to open any offices in OH?

A: Not at the moment however we are always looking at better ways to serve the community.

Q: Where is my child's chart kept?

A: All FSP patient charts are maintained by an electronic medical record system and can be access from any FSP office such as Weirton, Robinson, Beaver. In fact, your child may be seen in any FSP office as well.

Q: What about my scheduled appointment with Dr. Suray for Thursday, Dec 3rd?

A: Any existing appointments on the Steubenville schedule will be transferred to the Weirton schedule under the same provider, same date, same time as requested, unless you decide to make a change.

Q: What phone number can I call if I have questions?

A: Patients that have questions or have not yet visited the Weirton office at First Steps Pediatrics will have access to a dedicated coordinator for their first few visits. **Shawna Minella** will be available to help with all relocation matters including assisting patients to schedule with their preferred FSP providers.
